So, the use of the right light is important when you want a great look at the end of the "art" of applying your make-up. Your day makeup should look natural in harsh, bright light. The trick is to apply your makeup in an area of your home where daylight falls directly on your face as this light is the most true light.

Light from light globes can vary greatly and all will give a different look to your skin and makeup colours. So check to see how your office lighting affects your makeup design and experiment with different cosmetic colours to achieve the right look for you.

Makeup can tell a story as described above or simply make the small and large features of your facial contours more in harmony with each other. None of us are perfectly symmetrical so relax a bit more about how you look.
